Special Election Referendum Street Bonding

Tuesday, August 27, 2013—Maranatha Church

Voting for this referendum allows our city to systematically replace and restore streets throughout the city, without the need for assessments to property owners.



The council voted to hold the special referendum to approve bonding for street replacements on Tuesday, August 27, 2013 at Maranatha Church. Maranatha Church is located at 24799 Forest Blvd. Voting hours are 7:00 am to 8:00 pm.

On Election Day you will find the following language on the ballot, BY VOTING "YES" ON THIS BALLOT QUESTION, YOU ARE VOTING FOR A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE. (By Minnesota State Statute all bond referendums must have this language)

The city already has a built in a payment mechanism for the street replacement bonds. It's the street replacement fund that was approved by our council in 2012. This fund dedicates \$500,000 a year from our tax levy to pay for street replacements throughout our city. The \$500,000 levied in 2012 was payable on residents 2013 taxes. Any impact on your taxes levied for the street replacement fund would have been on your 2013 taxes. Bond payments, would only use part of that amount, and the balance will accumulate to allow the city to pay cash for future street replacements in the city's 10 year plan.

Our city will be scheduling several open house meetings over the next couple of months to answer and address concerns that our residents may have about the referendum.

The City of Wyoming will be holding informational meetings on the Street Bond Referendum on the following dates:
