**WYOMING PUBLIC WORKS SPRING REMINDERS** - Spring is a time for hydrant flushing, street sweeping and road restrictions

- Please watch for street sweepers in your area, and move any vehicles or obstacles that may block sweeping operations

**Chisago County Compost Site** – The Chisago County Compost site will open May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2014 or as weather permits until Saturday, November 22, 2014. The compost site is open Wednesdays 2 p.m. to 7 p.m. and Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Wyoming residents may follow Hwy 61 north, to CR 19 east (Stacy Trail), to intersection of County Road #77, then go (left) north .3 tenths of a mile to site on right.
