Zoning Administrator Weck was directed to add provisions to the draft ordinance based on what was discussed. The map draft will be left as is until the Commission has more time to study it.

5. Ordinance Amendment Snowmobile and Off-Road Vehicle Ordinance

The Commissioners discussed the changes that had made to the ordinance from the last meeting. The following further discussion the commissioners made the following observations and changes to the ordinance:

- 1) Add “streets” back to sec. 434 – 137, (6).
- 2) Replace “ATV” and “all-terrain vehicle” with “off-road vehicle” where applicable.
- 3) Correct the internal ordinance section reference in Sec. 34 – 159 (renumbered as 34 – 147).
- 4) Remove “boulevard easements” from items (7) and (8) in Section Sec. 34 – 151 in Article V (renumbered as 34 – 201).
- 5) Add “or one-half hour after dusk, whichever comes first” to item (7) in Section Sec. 34 – 151 in Article V (renumbered as 34 – 201).
- 6) Add a provision to Article V referencing State statute concerning the use of scooters by those under 18 years of age.

Weck was directed to make the revisions to the draft ordinance.
