PURPOSE OF THE MEETING:

Mark Erichson-City Engineer-Reviewed 10 Year Street Reconstruction Plan, reviewed areas for street reconstruction from 2013 to 2022.

Mayor Peterson-Reviewed spreadsheet comparing costs of bonding versus a pay as you go option. Explained that bonding saves the City the most money and believes that the council's duty is to be responsible fiduciary stewards representing what the residents' want.

Councilmember Nanko/Yeager-Compared funding methods, believes assessing residents will allow for street reconstruction to proceed swiftly. Believes assessments are the most fiscally responsible way to proceed.
