CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Eric Peterson called the worksession of the Wyoming City Council for June 19, 2012 to order at 5:15 PM at the Giese Memorial Library Conference Room.

PURPOSE OF THE MEETING:

The City Council held the worksession to review the proposal from BKV Group for purchasing and remodeling of the former Riverbank Building to serve as City Hall, and remodeling the current City Hall as a future Public Safety Building.

Administrator Mattson recapped the City of Wyoming's 2011 Strategic Plan and the City's mission, vision and goals from now until 2016. Administrator Mattson explained how this project fits in with the City's plans for the future.

Bruce Schwartzman from BKV Group walked through the proposal and explained the breakdown of costs and current deficiencies for current City Hall and Fire Station. Bruce also walked through the proposed layout of the new Public Safety Facility.

Chief Hoppe explained the organizational chart for Fire and Police Departments now and in relation to future population growth and the facilities that will be needed.
