*Council Member Nanko/Yeager – Would like to suggest that we use resolution B that sates a not to exceed levy amount of \$3,904,195, staff budget requests were less than 2013. Council Member Nanko/Yeager the city may not need to levy the full amount of \$4.1 million.*

*Mayor Peterson – Suggested that we cannot count on LGA*

*Council Member Elmore – this is just a not to exceed we have until December to finalize a budget.*

*Council Member Nanko/Yeager – Believes the city never came under a not to exceed levy. That’s why she hesitates to go with the higher amount.*
