

2020 STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT PROJECT NEWSLETTER #1 APRIL 30, 2020

Dear Property Owner or Current Resident:

We hope all is well with you and your family during these difficult times. In March, both the President of the United States and the Governor of Minnesota declared construction a critical infrastructure industry while the coronavirus pandemic persists, so the scheduled street improvement project will proceed as planned this summer.

The City Council awarded the construction contract for this project to Dresel Contracting, Inc. **The contractor plans to start work in June.** A more in-depth schedule will be available closer to the start of construction. The project will be completed by November, weather permitting. A map of the project area is enclosed.

The City of Wyoming allows working hours as follows:

Monday – Friday **7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.**
Saturday **8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.**
No work allowed on Sundays or holidays

To maintain the CDC's social distancing guidelines during construction, email will be the primary form of communication for updates about the project schedule and answer questions regarding the project. Email updates will likely be sent once a week to alert property owners and residents about where crews are working, construction progress, or if work is suspended due to weather. Recipients will be blind-copied, and **your email address will not be shared with anyone outside the project team.** These updates will also be placed on the City of Wyoming website project page. Ways to be engaged through social media will also be identified on this project page.

If you would like to be included in the email list to receive updates, please send an email to me at jpearson@wsbeng.com. You can ask to be removed from the list at any time via email or phone call. If you choose not to provide your email, you will still receive mailed paper copies of significant schedule and construction updates.

Property-specific or urgent matters will be communicated via doorhangers. An example of when a doorhanger would be used is when access to your driveway will be disrupted. In some project locations hydrants will be replaced and some short-term water shut-offs may occur as well. Watch for brightly colored door hangers on your front door.


