#### **The 2020 Street Improvement Project is Getting Underway!**

We hope all is well with you and your family. Summer is here and the contractor will soon be starting work on the 2020 Street Improvement Project.

The project will include street reconstruction and storm sewer installation on all streets west of Kettle River Blvd from 261st Ln. to 264th St. Street reconstruction will include subsurface corrections, concrete curb and gutter, and new pavement.

Private utility companies have already been in the area moving and updating their service lines in preparation for the street project. If you have concerns with their work, please contact those utilities directly.

#### **Stay Informed about the Project**

To maintain the CDC's social distancing guidelines during construction, email will be the primary form of communication for updates about the project schedule and to answer questions regarding the project. Email updates will likely be sent once a week to alert property owners and residents about where crews are working, construction progress, or if work is suspended due to weather. Recipients will be blind-copied, and your email address will not be shared with anyone outside the project team. These updates will also be placed on the City of Wyoming website project page. Ways to be engaged through social media will also be identified on the project page.

If you would like to be included in the email list to receive updates and have not already done so, please send an email to [jpearson@wsbeng.com](mailto:jpearson@wsbeng.com). You can ask to be removed from the list at any time via email or phone call. If you choose not to provide your email, you will still receive mailed paper copies of significant schedule and construction updates.

Property-specific or urgent matters will be communicated via doorhangers. For this project, an example of when a doorhanger would be used is when access to your driveway will be disrupted. In some project locations, hydrants will be replaced and some short-term water shut-offs may occur as a result.

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#### Tree Removals

Trees that are scheduled for removal will be marked. Please make certain you are aware of any tree removals that will occur adjacent to your property. It is expected that tree removals will begin as early as June 22nd.

#### Sprinkler Systems & Invisible Fences

If you have a sprinkler system or an underground invisible pet fence on your property, please contact the project's construction observer. They will provide you flags that you can use to mark the locations of these items.

#### Street Parking

Vehicle access to driveways will be provided at the beginning and end of each working day. If there becomes a time where access cannot be provided at these times, you will be notified at least 24 hours in advance.

#### Garbage Service

During construction, garbage haulers may not have access to the front of your property. When construction is taking place on your roadway, please use tape to label your trash receptacles with your address. On trash day, place curb side as early as possible. The project team will assist in moving receptacles to a location where the haulers can access them.

#### Mail Service

Temporary mailboxes will be set up to allow the post office to deliver mail to the project area. The City will work to keep residents informed where temporary mail service will be required and where the mailboxes will be located.

#### Driveway Paving

The project includes restoration of driveways that are disturbed within the project limits. At this time the paving contractor can not commit to being able to provide driveway replacement outside of the project limits at homeowners expense. Homeowners who are considering hiring their own contractor to replace their entire driveway should coordinate that work to occur after the installation of new curb. Further information about this schedule will be available in a future update.
