Minimum Control Measure 4 & 5

Construction Stormwater Runoff Control Post-Construction Stormwater Management

- ✓ Eight (8) active construction sites greater than one acre were inspected



Minimum Control Measure 6

Pollution Prevention and Good Housekeeping

- ✓ Quarterly Public Works inspections and maintenance
- ✓ Public Works staff and Police/Fire staff training
- ✓ Completed inspections for stormwater infrastructure:
 - ✓ Structural BMP inspections – 34
 - ✓ Outfall inspections – 33
 - ✓ Pond Inspections – 32
 - ✓ BMP maintenance
