Eric Zweber, WSB – Explained that he would be covering agenda items 15 and 16 at the same time. He gave a presentation that outlined the background and process thus far for the proposed Summer Fields development and the CUP for the Shoreland District which would approve a

Planned Unit Development. He noted that that the final plat request is just for the 1st addition of 19 lots. He noted that the Planning Commission has recommended approval of both the CUP and the Final Plat, with an added condition regarding street lighting.

Council Member Nanko Yeager – Stated that she has gotten feedback from residents that they are still concerned about the increased traffic along Kettle River and at the intersections of East Viking and Kettle River. She asked if there had been any more discussion about changes to the traffic recommendations to alleviate the continuing concerns.

City Engineer Erichson – Stated that they have looked at this issue and are confident in their responses in the staff report. He stated that he does think there is additional work to be considered regarding the intersection of East Viking and Kettle River. He noted that staff has not engaged the County of MnDot at this stage, but will plan to do that in the near future.

Council Member Nanko Yeager – Asked if it would be possible to provide additional screening on Kettle River more than the small trees that are proposed.

Eric Zweber, WSB – Stated that this is something that could be added as a condition, if the Council desired, but as it is currently written the developer would need to meet the landscape provisions as outlined in the City code.
