

RESOLUTION NO.: 14-06-46

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MINIMUM SEWER CONSUMPTION-WINTER AVERAGING RATES FOR RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES

Councilmember ELMORE offered the following Resolution Seconded by Councilmember J. ZERWAS and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, based on the new utility rate structure sewer consumption is established per every 100 gallons used during 1st quarter billing cycle

WHEREAS, residential properties unoccupied during the 1st quarter billing cycle having zero consumption will have a minimum consumption set at 7,000 gallons per quarter

WHEREAS, sewer consumption for any properties should never exceed actual water consumption

WHEREAS, sewer for commercial properties is billed based on actual water consumption each quarter

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the City of Wyoming authorizes a minimum consumption set at 7,000 gallons to be billed quarterly for properties unoccupied during the 1st quarter billing cycle


